

Introduction

In the spring of 2022 the Clinton County Health Department (CCHD) surveyed Clinton County residents to provide perspective about community health. Residents were asked to identify features of a strong, vibrant, healthy community; for their opinions on health, social and environmental challenges in the community; to identify health and social challenges and any barriers to medical care experienced by themselves or a family member within the past year; and, for demographic information about individual respondents and their households. The summary below outlines what respondents who indicated they reside in the Town of Plattsburgh identified as features, challenges or barriers and highlights how they compare to the responses of all Clinton County respondents.

Findings

A total of 1,081 responses were received from Clinton County residents. One hundred and seventy-three (173) of the respondents indicated they reside in the Town of Plattsburgh.

Demographics of Survey Respondents

The overall demographics of survey respondents who reside in the Town of Plattsburgh varied only slightly from those of Clinton County respondents overall. Four-fifths of survey respondents (79.19%) identified as female and 16.18% of respondents identified as male (4.05% of respondents chose not to answer this question and 0.58% selected 'other'). In regards to age, the majority of respondents were ages 45-64 (38.15%), followed by ages 25-44 (34.68%), ages 65-79 (13.87%), ages 18-24 (6.94%), 80 years and older (5.78%), and age 17 and younger (0.58%). All respondents indicated that the primary language spoken in their household was English. Ninety percent of respondents reported their race/ethnicity as white, while 2.89% selected as Hispanic, Latino or Spanish origin, 1.73% American Indian, 1.73% Asian or Pacific Islander, 1.16% Black or African American, and 1.16% selected 'other'. The highest level of education completed by survey respondents was diverse; 2.31% completed some high school but did not finish; 9.83% obtained a high school diploma or GED; 29.47% completed some college, obtained a technical or trade school certificate, or an Associate's degree; 26.59% obtained a Bachelor's degree; and 30.60% obtained a Master's degree or higher. The household annual income reported by respondents also varied; 12.72% reported a household annual income of less than \$24,999; 19.08% reported \$25,000-\$49,000; 21.97% reported \$50,000-\$99,999; and 31.21% reported \$100,000 or more. The majority of respondents are employed full-time (56.65%), retired (18.50%), or employed part-time (6.94%). When asked if they had a primary care provider (PCP), 92.29% indicated they were being followed by a PCP, while only 7.51% indicated they were not. The breakdown for all respondents' responses to demographic questions can be found in Table 1.

Definition of a Healthy Community

When asked whether they believed they live in a healthy community, 38.72% of respondents agreed or strongly agreed that they live in a healthy community; 28.33% disagreed or strongly disagreed with this



statement and 32.95% of respondents felt neutral toward this statement. Respondents were then asked to identify the top three features of a strong, vibrant, healthy community. The top features reported by residents were affordable housing (34.68%); health care services (35.26%); livable wages (34.10%); a clean environment (32.37%); and good schools (26.59%). The lowest ranked features were senior housing (4.05%); diverse populations (5.78%); transportation (6.36%); equality (6.94%); and good childcare (6.94%). Health Challenges of Concern and Experienced

Town of Plattsburgh residents identified overweight/obesity (48.55%); substance abuse (45.66%); access to mental health services (41.04%); mental health (40.46%); and access to a health care specialist (32.95%) as the top health related challenges of concern in the community. More than 91% of respondents reported they or a family member experienced one or more health challenge in the past year. The top challenges experienced were mental health (40.25%); overweight/obesity (38.99%); access to a health care specialist (32.70%); issues related to aging (31.45%); and chronic disease (29.56%).

Almost half of respondents identified substance abuse as a health challenge in the community, while just over 10% of respondents reported that they or a family member experienced it as a health challenge within the past year. Similarly, 41.04% of respondents identified access to mental health services as a challenge in the community, though only a quarter of them reported they or a family member had difficulty accessing mental health services within the past year. Additionally, two-fifths of respondents reported mental health was a health issue they or a family member experience in the past year, slightly higher than all Clinton County respondents (34.73%). Furthermore, 28.90% of respondents identified access to health care services as a top health challenge in the community, while only 18.24% reported having trouble accessing healthcare services. However, almost 65% of respondents reported they or a family member experienced at least one barrier to receiving medical care in the past year. The most reported barriers included; no specialist appointment was available (41.96%), there was no specialist locally (40.18%), did not accept my insurance (32.14%), could not leave work/school (24.12%), did not have vision or dental insurance (24.12%), and no primary care appointment was available (24.12%). Social Challenges of Concern and Experienced

Town of Plattsburgh residents identified the same top three social challenges in the community as all Clinton County residents surveyed, lack of a livable wage (42.77%), affordable housing (41.66%), and access to healthy foods (26.01%). Respondents also identified childcare (23.70%) and child abuse/neglect (23.12%) as social issues in the community. Almost three-quarters of respondents (72.83%) reported they or a family member experienced at least one social challenge in the past year. 2 in 5 (41.66%) respondents identified affordable housing as a top social concern in the community, while only a quarter (26.98%) of respondents or their family members experienced issues with affordable housing within the past year. Conversely, more than 30% of respondent or their family members experience issues with street safety in



the past year, though only 16% identified it as a social issue in the community. Other social issues experienced by respondents of their family members in the past year included; lack of a livable wage (34.92%), lack of employment opportunities (26.98%), and opportunities for physical activity (23.81%). Environmental Concerns


More than three-fifths (63.01%) of residents identified aging infrastructure as a top environmental concern in the community. Thirty-eight percent identified stream, river or lake quality as a top environmental concern, while 36.42% identified climate change. Town of Plattsburgh residents were more likely to select failing septic systems (18.50%) and less likely to select home safety (13.87%) than county residents (10.74% and 20.19% respectively). Self- Perceived Physical and Mental Health

The majority of respondents self-reported their physical health as average (40.46%) or good (38.15%). Only 8.09% reported their physical health as poor or extremely poor and 13.29% reported their physical health as excellent. A similar pattern in responses was seen for self-reported mental health with 87.86% of respondents reporting their mental health as average, good or excellent, 12.14% of respondents reported their mental health as poor or extremely poor. 


Figure 5: Clinton County Community Health Assessment Community Survey, Town of Plattsburgh Social Concerns (n=173)* 50% 43% 40% 30% 24% 23% 20% 10% 0% Town of Plattsburgh ■ Lack of a livable wage ■ Affordable housing Access to healthy foods ■ Childcare ■ Child abuse/neglect ■ Bullying
