SAFE FIREARM STORAGE





Unload - Remove all ammunition from the firearm, including chambered rounds.

2 Lock - Unloaded firearms should be secured with a locking device, such as a cable lock, or in a locked location, such as a safe.

Talk to a trusted health, behavioral health, or social service professional about safe firearm storage to protect you and your family.

Separate - Ammunition should be stored separately from the firearm in a secure location.
